
Notice of Submission of Environmental Assessment City of Elliot Lake Solid Waste Management Plan

The City of Elliot Lake has completed the environmental assessment for the Elliot Lake Solid Waste Management Plan for managing the City's residual waste over a 25-year planning period. As required under section 6.2(1) of the Environmental Assessment Act and according to the terms of reference approved by the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change on March 2009, the City of Elliot Lake has submitted its environmental assessment to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change for review and approval.

The City's existing landfill is expected to reach capacity by 2017. A means to dispose of the City's waste will be required before then. The City undertook a study to identify and evaluate a solution that would provide its residents with a feasible disposal solution for the next 20 years. The existing landfill is located approximately 1.5 km south of the City of Elliot Lake and 1.0 km north of Esten Lake. The EA study area is limited to the official boundaries of the City of Elliot Lake (see map below).





As required under the Environmental Assessment Act, the environmental assessment will be available for public review and comment from February 5, 2016 to March 25, 2016.
