City set to hire its next Chief Administrative Officer

(ELLIOT LAKE) The City of Elliot Lake has announced it has reached a decision to hire a familiar name as its next Chief Administrative Officer, Mr. Daniel Gagnon will be appointed with a bylaw at Council on Monday November 27th and will begin his second tenure with the City on January 2nd 2018.

Mayor Dan Marchisella confirmed the news: "City Council is delighted to welcome Dan back home to his roots, his recent experience as CAO and his open and positive management style are exactly what the city needs right now. We are calling it a mutually beneficial do-over and looking forward to working together for many years to come."

Mr. Gagnon held various positions with the City from 2001 to 2010 focusing on economic development and recreation. He was named interim then permanent CAO in 2010 before departing for a CAO opportunity in Eastern Ontario in February of 2011. Mr. Gagnon has undergraduate degrees in Canadian History and Economic Development in addition to several municipal courses and almost 7 years as CAO and Clerk for the Township of North Glengarry, a community in Eastern Ontario with a population of 10,250 and a 7 member Council.
